Senior Lecturer & Honorary Consultant in Paediatric Endocrinology



Dr Helen Storr graduated in Medicine in 1995 at the Royal London Hospital and after completion of core paediatric training; higher specialist paediatric endocrinology training was undertaken at Barts and the Royal London Hospital. She obtained a PhD in molecular endocrinology in Professor Adrian Clark's laboratory in the William Harvey Research Institute. Her PhD research has provided preliminary data for the primary disease mechanism for the pathogenesis of the Triple A Syndrome. She was awarded a HEFCE Clinical Senior Lecturer award and was appointed as a Clinical Senior Lecturer and Honorary Consultant in Paediatric Endocrinology at Barts and the Royal London Hospital in July 2007. In 2011, she was awarded the European Society for Paediatric Endocrinology (ESPE) Young Investigator Award.

Her ongoing research interest is the molecular basis of genetic childhood endocrine disease including TripleA syndrome, childhood Cushing's syndrome and genetics of growth and growth hormone insensitivity syndrome
