

**Mr Robert Carpenter MBBS MS FRCS  
Consultant Breast and Endocrine Surgeon**



Rob Carpenter qualified at Middlesex Hospital Medical School and subsequently trained at Hammersmith Hospital, Westminster Hospital and Charing Cross Hospital where he won a Trustees Research Fellowship and gained an MS thesis on cellular DNA content in early breast cancer. He was awarded the Norman Plummer Post Graduate Clinical Prize in 1988. He was appointed as Lecturer in Southampton in 1989 and Consultant Surgeon at St Bartholomew's Hospital in 1992.

He became Director of the merged Barts and Royal London Breast Service and the Founder Chairman of the North East London Cancer Network Breast Cancer Tumour Board in 2001 and subsequently founder MDT Chairman for the Inner East London Breast Disease Partnership. He was Clinical Lead for the Barts Cancer Centre of Excellence charity appeal (£13 million) for the award winning Breast Diagnostic Centre commissioned in 2004. He has been a Sessional Tutor (Basic Surgical Education) and Member of the Court of Examiners at the Royal College of Surgeons of England.
